OVERVIEW






The CapForce IBD[®] 50 ETF seeks to track the investment results of the IBD[®] 50 Index. IBD 50 is Investor's Business Daily[®] signature investing tool, providing exposure to U.S. large- and mid-cap companies demonstrating strong earnings and price strength characteristics. The Fund applies a consistent, rules-based selection process designed to identify stocks that meet defined leadership criteria.

Using a transparent methodology, the index selects companies with measurable earnings growth, technical momentum, and liquidity characteristics — emphasizing quantifiable leadership factors over discretionary stock selection.

IBD BREAKOUT PROCESS

- 1 UNIVERSE** IBD's database has information on more than 7,000 securities and research going back more than 100 years.
- 2 SELECTION** The IBD Breakout Stocks Index targets stocks exhibiting breakout characteristics based on fundamental and technical indicators.
- 3 WEIGHTING** Weights are assigned to each stock according to overall rank.
- 4 EVALUATION** Relative performance and sell signals trigger the replacement or rebalance of individual holdings, weekly. The proprietary market timing indicator has the ability to raise 50% cash.
